CLARIFICATION NOTES

Paint Bred Horses – can only compete in events specified as being for Paint Bred Horses.

Yearling Versatility – These events form the Yearling Versatility – Events 33 Yearling Lungeline, 35 Yearling Led Trail, 29 Yearling Hunter In Hand & **Yearling Versatility Halter. The 3 performance events are open to all Regular Registered yearling competitors and are not exclusively for Yearling Versatility entrants. To be considered for the Yearling Versatility award entrants must compete in the halter leg plus at least 2 of the 3 specified performance events and pay an additional Yearling Versatility Nomination of \$25-. Points are calculated as per the High Point System for the National Show across all of these events.

Event 29 - Yearling Hunter In Hand – Entrants not eligible for classes 30, 128, 129.

Events 9, 10, 11 – Hunter Hack – Approved Safety Helmet must be worn in this event and whilst warming up or over practice jump.

Event 58 – Jackpot All Breeds Reining 3 yrs & over – prior to the commencement of this event a Calcutta will be held. All competitors must participate in the Calcutta to be eligible to compete. The funds raised from the Calcutta will be dispersed at the discretion of the PHAA Board.

Events 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, Dressage events Horses may enter a maximum of 3 tests over two consecutive levels only. Approved Safety Helmet must be worn in this event and whilst warming up. Dressage events are run as per EFA rules. 2 Year Old horses are ineligible to enter. The same horse & rider combination must be maintained if the horse competes in different classes. Individual riders may compete on several different horses.

Event 94 Overo Colour Class & 95Tobiano Colour Class – Led events, dress and equipment as for halter events. Horse has to be entered in at least one class at the show, to be eligible to compete. Judged 60% on colour, 40% on conformation, coat pattern should have equal distribution of colour and white pattern. Horse must be PHAA registered as Overo or Tobero for Overo class and PHAA registered as Tobiano or Tobero for Tobiano class. Non point scoring event.

Event 127 - Get of Sire – Three regular registered get, either sex can be shown. Sire must be Regular or Paint Bred Registered with the PHAA, but need not be shown nor get need be owned by owner of sire. Horses actually shown as the Get of Sire will be limited to horses four years old and younger. The progeny of Paint Bred Horses will be eligible to be nominated for Get of Sire Class providing the Paint Bred stallion has one Regular Registered parent.

Events 91, 105, 124. – APHA Classes – All horses must be registered with the APHA.

Events 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 – Hack Classes – are open to all horses 14hh and over. Winners of classes 4,5,6,8 are eligible to compete for Grand Champion Hack. Grand Champion Hack will be a non point scoring event.

Event 19 – Suitability for Dressage – this is judged as a led event on the horse's suitability for dressage, based on conformation, movement and temperament.

** Indicates a leg of the Yearling Versatility – these legs are run within the National event

LATE ENTRY POLICY – Late entries will be taken at the Show Office up until 5pm the day before the event is to be held, provided there are already a minimum of 2 horses already entered in the event. Flat late penalty fee of \$50- per lodgement plus the normal entry fee, regardless of how many classes are late entered on that day.

Event 9 & 10 – Hunter Hack – Approved Safety Helmet must be worn in this event and whilst warming up or over practice jump.

133 YOUTH STICK HORSE CONTEST RULES - Entry fee – NIL

Eligibility – Open to all youth 8 years old and under. Entries will be taken on the day of event. The only requirement is that each youth competitor must be accompanied by their stick horse. Judging – Competitors will be judged on their ability to handle their stick horse, appearance and costume, the ability to proceed forward at several gaits. The judge may ask for a pattern to be “ridden” – example - a circle or a figure eight and or part of a trail pattern.
