This application must be in the PHAA office at **least 60 days prior to the entry deadline** of the show. Payment must accompany this application for PHAA approval. Late lodgment of application will incur a **\$50 rush fee**, in all instances the application must be in the office prior to 21 days before the closing date of entries for the show. Only classes listed on the program are accepted as eligible for points.

* Annual Approval will cover all shows within the period 1st August through to 31st July, provided no changes are made to the program. Should changes be made that would effect PHAA approval a new application will be required for that show. (E.g. Changing halter events for another breed will not effect PHAA approval).

Names of judges must be advised to the PHAA no later than 14 days prior to the date of the show. For shows conducted over consecutive days with different judges on each day they are classed as multi judge shows.

Show approval is based on rule 207 from the PHAA Rulebook. This approval is for the recording of points by the PHAA as submitted by the club only.

SHOW APPROVAL GUIDELINE SHEET

- Show Approval Application completed and signed
- Judge is HSAA or AQHA – State Show & Paint-o-Rama refer Rule 212
- Application must be in the PHAA office at least 60 days prior to the entry deadline of the show
- Correct Fees attached
- Program must be noted “under rules of HSAA/PHAA/AQHA” as applicable
- Copy of final program attached
- Refer list attached for mandatory classes
- Evidence of public liability insurance coverage (if Affiliated with the PHAA) see Rule 207.

As per rule 211A It is recommended that the following ribbon / sash colours be used at shows -

- * 1st Blue
- * 2nd Red
- * 3rd Yellow
- * 4th Green
- * 5th Brown
- * 6th Pink

Champion – Blue / white / red or if one colour only – Purple

Reserve Champion – Red / white / red or if one colour only Green

Grand Champion – Purple.

HIGH POINT AWARDS

It is mandatory at State Championship Shows and Paint-o-Ramas and recommended at other Shows that all High Point Awards that are available at a show be published along with the show program / entry forms and advertised in any printed schedule.

The classes that form each individual High Point Award should be specified to enable competitors the knowledge of each eligible award.

The following system of calculation is recommended –

6 or more entries in a class points are awarded = 6,5,4,3,2,1 with 1st being awarded 6 points and 6th being awarded 1 point.

5 entries in a class points awarded 5,4,3,2,1

4 entries in a class points awarded 4,3,2,1

3 entries in a class points awarded 3,2,1

2 entries in a class points awarded 2,1 1

entry in a class 1 point.

Any tie break system should also be advertised.

MINIMUM MANDATORY CLASSES FOR PHAA SHOW APPROVAL

As per Rule 201(h) Minimum class requirements for consideration of show approval shall be

HALTER **Paint Horses (Regular Registered)**
Filly 3 yrs & Under, Mare 4 yrs & over,
Champion & Reserve Champion Mare / Filly

Colt 3 yrs & Under, Stallion 4 yrs & over,
Champion & Reserve Champion Colt / Stallion

Gelding 3 yrs & Under, Gelding 4 yrs & over,
Champion & Reserve Champion Gelding

Paint Bred Horses
Filly 3 yrs & Under, Mare 4 yrs & over,
Champion & Reserve Champion Mare / Filly

Colt 3 yrs & Under, Stallion 4 yrs & over,
Champion & Reserve Champion Colt / Stallion

Gelding 3 yrs & Under, Gelding 4 yrs & over,
Champion & Reserve Champion Gelding

Further halter classes are encouraged.

The following classes are also recommended but are not compulsory –

GRAND CHAMPION or SUPREME CHAMPION PAINT HORSE
GRAND CHAMPION or SUPREME CHAMPION PAINT BRED HORSE
ENGLISH EQUITATION (or HUNT SEAT EQUITATION), WESTERN EQUITATION Amateur/Youth

From 1st April to July it is also advisable to have 2YO classes for Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure and Trail.

Numbers permitting it is advisable to further divide Youth classes to have Junior Youth 13 years & under and Senior Youth 14 years to 18 years. Lead Line and Walk/Trot classes may also be considered if there are a number of young competitors in your area.

From 1st August 2020 – RWD has been made compulsory for all shows. Anyone wishing to compete in RWD on a Registered Paint Horse MUST hold a current endorsed PHAA Exemption card.
